1. Motion Second

To approve the provisional appointment of William Baker to the position of Director of Technology effective November 20, 2023 at a salary of \$68,000 per year with a probationary period from November 20, 2023 to November 21, 2024. This position will be filled on a provisional basis pending the results of a Civil Service examination to be scheduled at a later date.

2. Motion Second

To Approve the four year 1.0 FTE probationary appointment of Rachael M. Pollak as a Pre-Kindergarten Teacher effective November 6, 2023 – November 5, 2027 in the tenure area of Elementary at Step 1 Masters of the GTA Salary Schedule.

In order to be eligible for tenure, individuals receiving a probationary appointment as a classroom teacher must receive annual composite or overall APPR ratings of Highly Effective or Effective in at least three of the four preceding years. If the individual received a rating of Ineffective in the final year of the probationary period, (he or she) will not be eligible for tenure at that time. The regulations do not require that a teacher have Professional Certification at the time of tenure but the District may make it a requirement.
