#### **PUBLIC COMMENT PROCEDURE**

The Board of Education recognizes the privilege of all citizens in the Galway Central School District to address the Board of Education concerning any item on the Board Meeting Agenda. Toward this objective, the Board of Education includes two opportunities for public comment which are listed on each Board Meeting Agenda. The Board of Education respectfully requests that all citizens addressing the Board during public comment recognize that inquiries or comments pertaining to students or personnel are confidential and cannot be brought up in public session for discussion. The Board will adhere to the following guidelines pertaining to public comments at Board Meetings:

- Individuals who wish to address the Board must be recognized by the Board President before speaking.
- Once recognized, the individual is to clearly state their name prior to speaking.
- Comments may be addressed to any Board member who will respond as he or she feels appropriate.
- In order for the Board of Education to conduct its business in a timely and efficient manner, it may be necessary on occasion to restrict public comment to a period of time not to exceed five (5) minutes.
