YES 325 NO 150 Passed  Proposition #2: Shall the Board of Education of the Galway Central School District be authorized to lease two (2) four wheel drive suburban vehicles, one (1) twenty-two passenger school bus and three (3) seventy-two passenger school buses for a five year term at an annual cost not to exceed \$80,000 and to levy the necessary tax?  YES 302 NO 136 Passed  Two vacancies on the Board of Education. Both are four-year terms of office that begin on July 1, 2009 and end on June 30, 2013.
