EDUCATIONAL PRESENTATION	Mr. Andy Forneris, Transportation Supervisor, reported on the District's Transportation Department. Thirty nine bus routes are driven every morning and again in the afternoon transporting kids back and forth to school. Two additional bus routes are contracted by outside vendors. Approximately 1800 miles are driven daily. The fleet consists of 27 buses, ranging in year from 1994-2009, and one 2008 Chevy Tahoe. Some are leased and some were purchased. The Board is looking into whether it is most cost effective to purchase or lease buses in the future.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT	A community forum took place in early January to discuss the budget and get input on where the district can cut costs. The Governor announced that NYS will be getting \$6.4 billion as part of a Federal Stimulus Package over the next 2 years geared toward education. A large portion will go to schools in NYC and some has to be spent on construction projects as part of the Governor's effort to stimulate the economy and create jobs. No further information is available. A 3-year budget revenue plan will be presented at the next meeting.
