








Current Revenue Budget

What we know:

- TRS is expected to increase by 3.66 to 4.66 percentage points
 - That equates to a 31-39% year-to-year increase
 - That totals an increase between \$216-269k, or 1.25-1.55% of budget
- GTA contract salaries will increase:
 - Approximately \$183,554, or 1.06% of budget

What we know:

- Health care costs will increase approximately 10%
 - Employer costs are expected to increase approximately \$223,020, or 1.29% of budget.

1.00% of Budget = \$173,430

1.00% of Tax Levy = \$90,977

Implication:


3.90% of Budget = 7.45% of Tax Levy*

What we don't know:

- Local Tax Levy Limit
- CSEA Contract Negotiations
- Cost of ERS (based on contract negotiations)
 - Rate increases as much as 5.0 percentage points
 - Equivalent of 24% year-to-year increase
- Impact of Assumed Amortization on Building Aid
