Approve the following Advocacy Priorities Resolution for the 2017 Legislative Session:

WHEREAS, the Galway Central School District strives to provide an outstanding education and post-secondary pathway for each and every student; and

WHEREAS, the District works diligently to meet the needs of all students while still fulfilling the ever increasing list of state mandates and contractual obligations; and

WHEREAS, our School District's free and reduced lunch rate has increased from 13% in 2010-11 to 34% in 2016-17.

WHEREAS, the district continues to work diligently to create a balanced budget that respects the needs of area taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, property tax levy legislation at the state level has provided an increased need for State Aid to maintain quality programs; and

WHEREAS, public schools are being asked to do more for students than ever before, so they are prepared for college, military or a career; and

WHEREAS, each child in the Galway Central School District only has one opportunity to go through the full elementary and secondary educational experience;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Galway Central School District Board of Education calls on the New York State Legislature and Governor Andrew Cuomo to act upon the following priorities:

- A. Fund and Adjust the Foundation Formula
 - Review and Update the Foundation Amount currently \$6,395.00 per pupil.
 - Update the formula to accurately reflect a district's income wealth factor for districts below .65.
 - Adjust the weighting factor for Free and Reduced Lunch to reflect the accurate measure of student need of a district.
 - Maintain the "SAVE Harmless" provision.
- B. Increase the \$30,000 Threshold on BOCES Aid for Career and Technical Education (CTE) Programs by providing 100% aid ability for the salaries of CTE teachers.
- C. Adjust the District (Regional) Superintendent Salary Cap
 - The Districts in the WSWHE BOCES region encourage the legislature to remove the reference to Commissioner's salary in the 2003-2004 fiscal year, and link the cap to the Commissioner's current salary.
- D. Small Group Insurance
 - Support is needed for legislation that changes the "small group" definition back to 1-50 employees and extends the protection that currently allows

school districts with 51-100 employees to remain in their Health Care Consortiums or Trusts beyond the two years.
